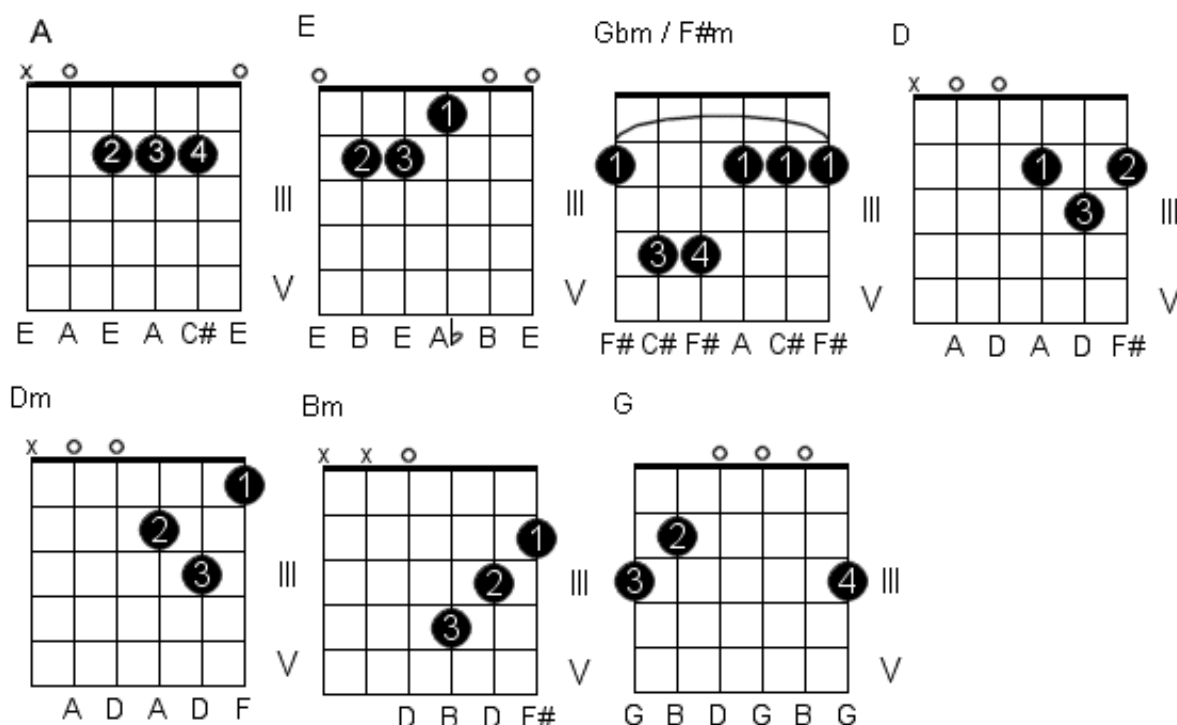
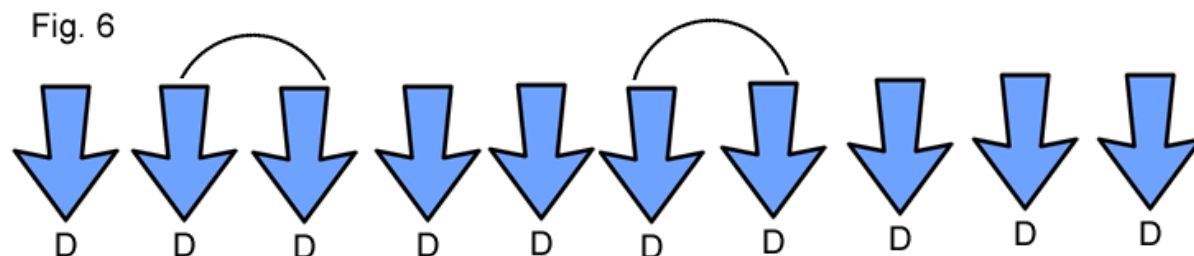


"In My Life"

Of course, it doesn't sound as cool without anything behind it, but it still works well with the song. The whole song uses mostly downstrokes. I MAY have thrown an upstroke in there, but I didn't see it in slow motion, so no harm no foul. This is a real 'feeling' type of song, so just listen to it a few times before getting into the nuts and bolts of it. The words come quickly at times, so be ready for that. They are a little off center from the chords themselves in the original recording, much like the way Dave Matthews tends to slur lines into the next passage. The intro and outro riffs are actually quite easy, so this will allow you to enhance some of your 'lead' work, though this isn't really a lead type of riff. It's more of a....riff type of riff. LOL. (say that three times fast!)
