


This one is slightly more specific, so I'm giving you my suggested fingerings both for the picking and fretting hand

The only part I didn't really tab out is the part that goes toward the violin solo. It's actually really simple in terms of formation. However, it's your call as to whether or not you want to play that part. I've seen plenty of cover acts that completely omit it. It's a bit strange to play when there's no backing guitar in it. To me, this song is all about the fingerstyle, which is definitely one big series of riffs.

I think you'll be surprised when you pull up the PDF on this. It's instanely consistent. If you can get the intro down, the rest is basically the same. All you have to do is switch the chords when it's time.




