
Quick Notes on "Bad Moon Rising" by CCR

You'll find a few extra guitar parts in the PDF, but the real fun is actually in the main rhythm guitar. Feel free to strum this any way you wish, and you CAN simplify the chords to all open position, but that's not truly how the original song goes.


The tabs below give you the strumming patterns that I would suggest. The chords in terms of progression are very simple to understand.

Here's the intro:




The main action here takes place on the G string during the D run.

Here's the verse:



This time you switch to the open D, but again – you CAN play the open A and G chords if you can't get the barre chords down. The verse is repeated 4 times. The PDF of the full score will reflect this as well.

Here's the chorus:



I'm also including all the open chord versions below if you decide to insert those into the progression in lieu of the barre chords.
