
Chord Reference File/Quick Notes: "Who'll Stop The Rain" - CCR Tempo: 123 bpm


While you are absolutely free to pull up the full score PDF, everything you really need is included here. This is MOSTLY a strumming song, with the exception of the riffy part that can be played over any of the G chords in the song.

The strumming pattern for the intro is this:



This ends up being DUDUDUDU | DUDUD - D (repeat)

The verse is consistent for the most part, but you can strum it either way shown below:




The first option would likely be a bit more like the original, with the pattern being:

DUDU - UDU | DUDU - UDU [vs.] DUDU - DUD | DUDU - DUD

Either works, but sometimes strumming two downstrokes (like in the second one) is a bit hard at first.

The interlude/instrumental is easier if you see the tab:



That's all you really need for the main guitar. You can use the chord reference file below to practice as I think it's easier to understand.

Intro :

Verse 1 :

(G) C/G G
Long as I remember, the rain been comin' down

Verse 3:

(G) C/G G Heard the singers playing, how we cheered for more. (G) Bm C/G G The crowd then rushed together, tryin' to keep warm.



Outro (almost same as intro):



You can play the following over ANY "G" chord, with an example showing you when it comes in after the second verse (the Bm is the tell-tale):



Remember: you can play this over ANY of the G's. The interlude is this:
