

While there are only 3 basic guitar parts in this song, the structure IS a bit confusing at first. However, there's one "guitar" part (synthesizer) that plays the moment the first verse starts. It quite literally plays over and over.


The other guitar part is the funky lil' guy – and that one is likely the hardest part of the whole song.

The last guitar part is really just a thick added tone in the interlude.


Here's the funky guitar part:



It might take a few tries, but if you play it exactly how it is arranged above you'll get it. Here's the super repetitive backing guitar, which would be a GREAT dexterity builder in terms of practice:



Just use your 1<sup>st</sup>, 2<sup>nd</sup>, and 3<sup>rd</sup> fingers if you can. You might try 1<sup>st</sup>, 3<sup>rd</sup>, and 4<sup>th</sup>, but I think it might get a littl confusing. The other guitar is this, which is super easy:



Consider playing a full C#5 (x-4-6-6-x-x) into B5 (x-2-4-4-x-x) and then F#5 (2-4-4-x-x) if you want to rock it out!
